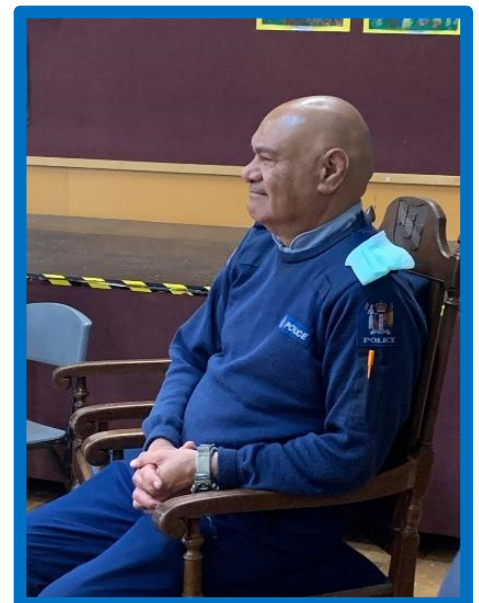

Enrolment Scheme – Kiwitea School

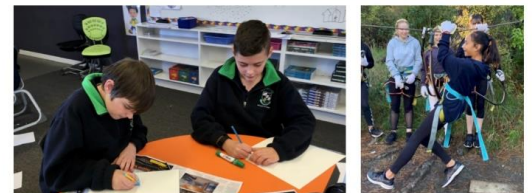
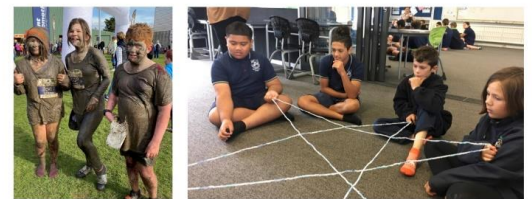
As you may be aware, the Kiwitea School Board have been working collaboratively with the Ministry of Education to develop an enrolment scheme.
